



Mentoring Program

ASIE Mentoring Program is a free service offered to the college students of Houston Metropolitan area. The service could not only be helpful to the students looking to find employment but also those who want to start their own business in the fields of engineering or architecture. The highly experienced ASIE Mentors would support the Mentee's success by offering their advice on a one-on-one basis in Mentee's areas of interest.

The ASIE Mentors volunteer their time to help college students, by sharing their real-world experience in working for small companies or large corporations or running successful small businesses. ASIE Mentors bring years of professional experience, many of them are successful professionals from various industries.

ASIE Mentors would help guide but will not make decisions for the mentees. They also cannot provide any immigration or legal advice. However, ASIE Mentors can provide useful guidance, only on volunteering basis, about the available options so the mentee can make better decisions.

ASIE mentoring sessions are collaborative meetings between the Mentee seeking path and the ASIE Mentor. At these sessions, the Mentee could share his/her goals, challenges and questions to which the Mentor will offer guidance and advice so the Mentee could decide the path forward.

The Mentoring sessions will be approximately one hour long which will be held either virtually or via phone calls or and even in person. Further correspondence could be by emails. The relationship between the Mentee and ASIE Mentor could as long as it is necessary.

In order to have successful sessions, it is recommended that the Mentees identify their needs, complete the Pre-match-questionnaire Mentee form in as much detail as possible, schedule a session after ASIE Public Outreach Committee matches the mentee with the Mentor, start and then complete intended goals.
