WHEREAS, the American Society of Indian Engineers and Architects (ASIE) was founded in Houston on August 15, 1994, with the goal of assisting Indian engineers and architects with securing employment, advancing their careers, and helping reach their business goals; and

WHEREAS, 2024 marks the 30th anniversary of ASIE providing a space where engineers and architects of Indian origin can network, volunteer, recognize the outstanding achievements of its members, and work with supporters to make a difference throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, ASIE has a storied history of helping to educate and uplift Harris County and Greater Houston's Indian community through organizing events, hosting webinars with industry and community leaders, and sharing information on hiring trends, employability, and employee rights; and

WHEREAS, since 1998, the organization has helped open the door for students pursuing engineering and architecture degrees in the Greater Houston Metropolitan Area and Texas through the ASIE Annual Scholarship Program, which has provided \$250,000 in scholarships to date; and

WHEREAS, on September 12, ASIE will host its 30th Anniversary Gala, which brings together industry leaders and professionals while raising funds that go toward ASIE's Annual Scholarship Fund, which has supported more than 80 students achieve their dreams of attending college and striving toward an engineering or architecture degree; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Harris County Commissioners Court hereby honors the

for its 30th anniversary and for its work to uplift students, engineers, and architects of Indian origin throughout the Greater Houston Area.
